POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Location: COS Annual Meeting Exhibit Hall – Room 517BCD, Palais des congrès

Set-up: Thursday, June 15, 1200-1700

Tear-down: Sunday, June 18, 1330-1600

Size: Total usable space per poster board is 90" wide by 40" high

Poster award presentation: Current Concepts I, Friday, June 16, 0800-1000

Poster presentation schedule: Organized by subspecialty and scheduled during the breakfast (0700-0800) and the morning break (1000-1045), Friday June, 16 – Sunday, June 18. For the detailed schedule, please see below.

Poster Design: Strong posters focus on communicability, scientific communication and scientific merit/value. Keep the following items in mind when designing your poster:

- Title and author names that are easily identifiable
- Research question, background, methods, results, discussion and conclusion are relevant, logical and linked to one another
- Innovative research, rigorous methods and conclusions supported by results
- Engaging, clear and eye catching poster design
- Formatting is appropriate and logical; graph and tables are clear and easily visible
- Clear information that can be read in 3-4 minutes

Poster Presentation Schedule

You are requested to be at your poster during breakfast (0700-0800) and morning breaks (1000 to 1045) to answer questions. We've scheduled specific days for specific subspecialties. You are welcome to be at your poster during the designated question periods on other days, however it is not mandatory.

Friday, June 16: Oculoplastics and Retina

Saturday, June 17: Cornea, Glaucoma, and Pediatrics

Sunday, June 18: Cataract, International and Public Health, Uveitis, and Vision Rehabilitation

Please note that your poster must stay up for the duration of the meeting.
