

The Thunder Bay Ophthalmology Group is looking to recruit a **Comprehensive Ophthalmologist** in preparation for the imminent retirement of one of our ophthalmologists. Subspecialty experience (Cornea / Glaucoma / Uvea / Oculoplastics) will be considered an asset, but is not a requirement.

The position will have operating privileges at the Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre, which is equipped with a cataract surgery suite with a new Zeiss microscope and a B&L phacoemulsification machine. We have office space available for the potential candidate to start practice right away. The office is equipped with Zeiss HVFs, Topcon OCTs, and an IOLMaster 700.

Academic appointment (subject to eligibility) is available at the Northern Ontario School of Medicine University (NOSMU), but is not a requirement. Teaching roles for medical students and family practice residents are available with NOSMU, if desired. Research facilities including funding, research assistants and coordinators are available, if desired.

Funding: Clinical duties will be fee for service. Additional funding is available through the Northern Physician Retention Initiative, NOSMU stipends, Northern Ontario Academic Medicine Association (NOAMA) stipends, and hospital on call stipends.

Call commitments: One week in every four weeks

Start date: Flexible, preferably February 2025

The potential candidate must be eligible for a College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) license to practice in Ontario. Internationally trained candidates with Canadian fellowship experience are welcome to apply.
